-Office Hours-

Our office officially opens on August 30th, from 8:00-3:00pm each day. If you have any questions or concerns, you can connect via phone, email or by booking an in-person visit (just call the school to book an appointment). If you do visit the school in person, please remember to wear a mask and sign in at the from desk. As well, visitors may not enter the building if they are experiencing any Covid-19 related symptoms, or have been asked to quarantine or isolate due to travel or being a close contact of someone with Covid-19.

Some Important Considerations:

- The mask mandate will remain the same as it was at the end of last school year.
 All staff and students in Gr.4-6 are required to wear masks in the building at all
 times. Mask wearing remains optional for students in K-3. Please keep in mind
 that there are still mask exemptions for Gr. 4-6 students. These will be
 communicated to parents next week.
- Morning health checks for staff and students will still be required each day.
 Anyone presenting with flu or cold-like symptoms will be required to stay home and follow medical advice.
- Cohorts are no longer recommended by our Provincial Health Officer and will not be used.
- Extracurricular activities are allowed this year.
- Food programs are allowed to continue this year.

More health and safety information will be communicated next week when our District health and safety measures are finalized and made public.

-Overview of our First Week Back-

Our students will return to their old classrooms between September 7th and 9th. The first day of school, September 7th will begin at 8:30am and finish at 11:00am. September 8th will be our first full day of school (see new bell schedule in next section).

September 7-9:

- **Returning Students, Gr. 1-6**: These students will go back to their physical classrooms that they attended last year. They will line up in the morning and be released in the afternoon at their old classroom doors.
- New Students, Primary (Gr. 1-3): Students will line up and be released at our library entrance.
- New Students, Intermediate (Gr. 4-6): Students will line up outside Division 2.
- **New Kindergarten Students:** Gradual entry programs were communicated to parents in the spring of 2021 and will be emailed to parents in a separate letter.

Signs will be located at the front of the school to direct new families to the library and Division 2 entrance doors.

September 10th and Beyond:

Students will begin in their new classrooms on Friday, September 10th. Class placements will be emailed to families Thursday evening. Students will line up in the morning and be released in the afternoon from their new classroom doors. A map of the school will be provided when class placements are emailed to families on the Thursday evening.
