*Our Route:*

*East on Cherry >> North on Cade Barr >> North on Dewdney Trunk >> West on Dalke >> West on Egglestone >> South on Cedar and back to the school gym.*

Teacher supervision will spread throughout the route and at the school.

If you, for any reason, **do not** want your child to join us on this run, on Thursday, please indicate below and have it returned to your child's teacher by Wednesday September 25th.

Students from grade 4-6 who are not running the route will be asked to stay at the school and run on the track.
