
Popcorn Friday



While our PAC is the parent voice at the school level, the purpose of a District PAC is to be the parent voice at the School District Level. Mr. Sliziak or Mrs. Zimmerman will typically attend our PAC meetings to give a Principal's report and Mr. Angus Wilson, the superintendent, will typically attend DPAC meetings to give a Superintendent's report. Each individual PAC has two elected DPAC representatives who are voting members of the DPAC. Every parent with a registered child in the School District #75 is a non-voting member of DPAC and can attend the meetings.
